Since 1974, the Department of Health has provided a screening service to children commencing Transition in Primary Schools. Following a recent review of service delivery, it was identified that many children are receiving two assessments at 4-5 years of age, one being a full assessment and immunization with the parents present in the Health Centre and another at school.
